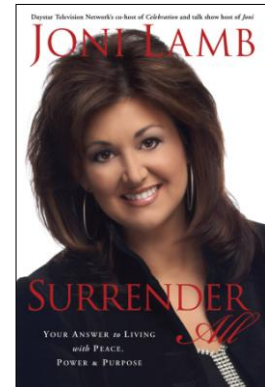


**“SURRENDER ALL”

No one can hold it all together, all the time. The economy is ever changing, job security is a thing of the past and broken relationships and broken families are becoming more of a rule rather than the exception. The only way to keep your head above water in today’s changing world is to give it all up. Let go and watch as God reveals his will for your life, and guides you in the right direction.

This is the overarching theme of Joni Lamb’s first book, “Surrender All: Your Answer to Living with Peace, Power & Purpose” (ISBN: 978-1-4000-7375-7). Lamb is co-founder and vice president of Daystar Television Network, the fastest-growing Christian television network in the world. Through inspirational stories and examples from her own life, Lamb shows how God can restore lives and give purpose to those who simply let go, and allow God to direct them.



In “Surrender All,” which was released in September 2008, Lamb shares stories of personal friends and Bible figures who have risked drowning in an attempt to maintain ultimate control over their lives. Treading water in an ocean of worries and troubles brings nothing but exhaustion. Joni reminds the reader that God wants nothing more than to save His people, as long as we let Him be the guide.

Lamb walks readers through the process of surrender in areas of life that are filled with storms and struggles; areas where we yearn for control but never fully attain it. Marriage, children, career, health, relationships, loss, failure, even the day-to-day living that can be so challenging, all need to be turned over to God before finding perfect peace in both the smooth and turbulent times of life.

Using the example of Jesus’ ultimate surrender to his Father’s will in the Garden of Gethsemane, Lamb explains that sacrifice isn’t painless or easy, but the end result is a life filled with purpose. Jesus struggled with his impending death but gave control of the situation to God, and in doing so He saved the souls of all who accept Him.

In her book, Lamb states, “Exciting times lie ahead for all willing to surrender. Life will not be perfect, nor will it be painless. But there is no greater life than the one that follows the path God sets before it. The path of surrender is a place of peace within a place of rest. Each of us is born uniquely gifted and talented, and to use our talents and abilities as God intended provides the purpose of our lives.”
