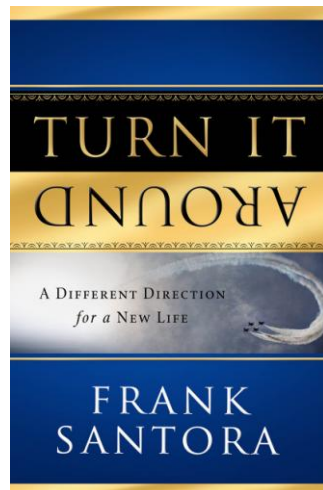
Seven solutions to ‘Turn It Around’
