Author Says Christians Can't Find Security in Tax Refund or Paycheck: Book Tells How to Find True Success in 'Turbulent Financial Times'

WHAT: Rick Dunham, author of "[Secure: Discovering True Security in Turbulent Financial Times](#)," believes that most Christians incorrectly equate stewardship with tithing. They believe that once they give to the church, they can do what they please with the rest of their money. And they end up finding a false sense of security in their paycheck or tax refund that undermines their Christian walk.

As tax season winds to a close, when most of us think about how we've handled our money in the past year and how much we've given to causes greater than ourselves, Dunham says that the recession should be a wake-up call, challenging Christians to seriously consider what they rely on for their security.

The book will be published Friday, April 15.
