Creation Museum Hosts Picnic at the Pavilion Answers in Genesis provides summer family fun

WHAT: The Creation Museum is once again hosting a Picnic at the Pavilion as a family-friendly alternative for summer outings. Available activities include hay wagon rides, K9 demonstrations, face painting and balloon twisting. Backyard Critters animal workshops will be provided and local area restaurants will be on hand selling featured selections from their menus.

DETAILS: There is no ticket required to attend this outdoor family event. Camel rides will be available in our petting zoo for a small fee; the Creation Museum will be open these days and requires a ticket for entry.

Food vendors will include our own Noah's Café, along with Bruster's Ice Cream, Famous Dave's BBQ, Hawaiian Ice, Sub Station II, Culvers, Wings on Wheels, Oriental Wok, Edwardo's Pizza, and Be Creative Catering.

The museum has continued to draw crowds more than four years after opening, with more than 1.3 million visitors to date. The museum is constructing an observatory with large telescopes and a 1,000-seat auditorium on its site. The parent ministry, Answers in Genesis, has received increased attention lately due to the recent Ark Encounter announcement, a full-scale, all-wood Noah's Ark and other themed attractions to be built in northern Kentucky.
