Does God Answer Prayers About Lost Jobs?

New Book Explains How You Can Rely on Him in Troubled Times

IRVINE, Calif., Sept. 28, 2011 – Jason Frenn has written a book for everyone who has ever wondered if God hears their prayers about a lost job, mounting bills or a serious illness. In ["The Seven Prayers God Always Answers: God's Promises for Everyone, Everywhere, Every Time."](#) Frenn shows that anyone who calls on God with a sincere heart will receive an audience.

At what President Obama calls "an urgent time for our country," when many people struggle to see God's hand in their lives, Frenn uses powerful stories from his work as a missionary and evangelist to help readers understand God's heart so they can pray more effectively.

The book, being released Oct. 19, 2011 by FaithWords, part of the Hachette Book Group, gives biblical insight into the power of prayer, specifically touching on the prayers for direction, forgiveness, freedom, provision, healing, blessing and salvation.

Frenn tackles controversial subjects in the chapters on provision and healing.

"I will never suggest that God heals every person who prays for a physical miracle," he writes. "If that were the case, I could have stopped taking my blood pressure and cholesterol medications when I was 38. But I do believe God offers answers, solutions, remedies and open doors to those who seek him. I believe healing is not just a physical phenomenon. It is spiritual, psychological and interpersonal. God's healing touches every area of our lives."

Frenn also makes it clear that, although he does not believe in the so-called "Prosperity Gospel," he does believe that God will provide, citing examples from the Bible and personal experience.

Frenn dispels several myths about prayer, including the idea that our faith or theology determines God's response. Frenn writes that although "faith is an essential ingredient that helps us connect with God, it is not the most important. I discovered a heart that is sincere and genuine is what the Lord values most."
