## Free Psalm Project Benefit Concerts Dutch Musical Group Will Perform in Chicago Area Jan. 28-29

**CRETE, Ill., Jan. 3, 2012** – Traveling thousands of miles from the Netherlands, The Psalm Project, a musical group that sings lyrics from the Old Testament book of Psalms will perform two free concerts in the Chicago area using words from one of the most-loved books in the Bible. The concerts will benefit Bible League International®, a ministry dedicated to spreading God’s Word around the world.

This Netherlands-based group draws from the Dutch tradition of singing from the song book composed primarily from the book of Psalms – known as the song book of the Bible. These lyrics were considered by Protestant Church Reformer, John Calvin, to be God’s very own Words placed in the worshippers’ mouths and sung through them.

The Psalm Project arranges these traditional, yet freshened texts into contemporary versions of the historic tunes featuring piano, guitar and strings. The free concerts will be held:
