## **NAE to Hold Public Forum on Respecting Sex, Reducing Abortions at Wooddale Church** New initiative to focus on lowering abortion rate in the U.S.

**WHAT:** As part of a new initiative to help reduce the abortion rate in the U.S., the National Association of Evangelicals (NAE) will host a public forum on what the church can do on June 4 at Wooddale Church in Eden Prairie, Minn.

The NAE recently launched the Generation Forum, which will focus on opening a respectful and productive dialogue in the Church and other appropriate forums about realistic ways to lower the amount of abortions being performed in the U.S. each year.

**WHO:** Dr. David Clark, Provost of Bethel University, will be the primary speaker at the forum. There will also be a panel of distinguished experts to lead a discussion about practical and realistic ways to reduce abortion rates.
