Jason Frenn

Jason Frenn is a dynamic speaker and author who uses biblical principles and stirring personal testimonies to inspire audiences around the world. His books “Breaking the Barriers,” “Power to Change” and the upcoming release, “Power to Reinvent Yourself,” reveal his unique approach to crusade ministry and deep passion for reaching the lost.

Born in Los Angeles, Calif., and raised in Southern California, Frenn grew up in what he humorously calls a crazy family. While growing up in a nontraditional home where divorce, alcoholism and family discord were the norm, he realized he could not break the cycle of dysfunction alone.

After a Hispanic family invited him to attend church in 1982, Frenn began to reach out to God for help and eventually found the strength in Christ to overcome the destructive patterns that had plagued his family for years. In 1991, he left his job as a highly-successful sales representative in the corporate world and began serving full-time in ministry.

After earning a Bachelor of Arts degree in history/political science and a Master of Arts in church leadership from Vanguard University, Frenn and his wife, Cindee, who is also an ordained minister, moved to Costa Rica as missionaries with the Assemblies of God fellowship. He dedicated a year to learn Spanish in language school before beginning to preach at conferences throughout Costa Rica.

Frenn has traveled the world as a missionary-evangelist, holding more than 50 evangelistic citywide outreaches in Latin America and the United States. He is uniquely gifted in communicating the Gospel to people who do not attend church.

In addition, Frenn is a renowned and highly sought after conference speaker for churches, nonprofit organizations and business audiences. He has spoken to over 3 million people – 250,000 of whom made first-time decisions to follow Christ.

The founder of Taking It to the Nations and Power to Change International, Frenn hosts a daily live radio program on the Radio Nueva Vida Network, with a listening audience of 475,000 people. He is a frequent guest on Crystal Cathedral’s “Hour of Power.”
