

### **Reg Grant**

Dr. Reg Grant serves as Professor of Pastoral Ministries at Dallas Theological Seminary, where he teaches courses in preaching, drama, voice, creative writing and creative radio production. He is also the director of the Master of Arts in Media and Communications Degree Program and the Media Arts in Ministry track at DTS.

Grant has written, produced and acted for radio, television, theater and film, working with Grace Products, Walk Thru the Bible Ministries, Coral Ridge Ministries, RBC Ministries, Child Evangelism Fellowship, CAM International, Probe Ministries, SIM (Serving in Mission), International Bible Society and others. Grant lent his voice for the audio NET Bible reading of Psalms, Proverbs and the New Testament. He serves on the advisory board for Nest Entertainment and stars in its Emmy-winning DVD series, "In Search of the Heroes," about historical figures such as Susan B. Anthony, Anne Frank, Sam Houston, Helen Keller, William Barret Travis and Harriet Tubman.

Grant, a professor at DTS since 1982, has authored or coauthored several books, including two works of fiction, "Ebony Moon" and "Storm." He has a bachelor's degree from Texas Tech University and a master's and a doctorate from DTS. Grant's multi-faceted career allows him to contribute the conversation concerning the trending topic of end-times in entertainment. His theological education and artistic background give him distinctive insight into the "The Road" and its importance.

### **Phil Hotsenpiller**

Phil Hotsenpiller is the teaching pastor of Yorba Linda Friends Church, a megachurch in Southern California. Hotsenpiller obtained his Bachelor of Arts degree from Southwest Baptist University, Master of Divinity from New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary, and post-graduate studies at Christ Church College, Oxford University.

Hotsenpiller has served as adjunct professor at Boyce Bible College and Union Theological Seminary and conducted evangelistic crusades in Mexico, Brazil, Paraguay, El Salvador, Honduras, Guatemala, Romania, Yugoslavia and France. Hotsenpiller is the President of New York Executive Coaching Group and the co-author of a seven volume business series entitled, "Passionate Lives and Leaders." His theological knowledge of biblical End Times prophecy is what inspired his partnership with comic book artist Rob Liefeld to develop the "Armageddon Now" graphic novel series.

Along with Liefeld and businessman Michael Gadd, Hotsenpiller co-founded 12 Gates Productions, a Christian-based entertainment company that is releasing the "Armageddon Now" graphic novel series. Hotsenpiller uses his theological expertise to write graphic novel stories that combine biblical prophecies, superhero characters and "ripped-from-the-headline" news.

Hotsenpiller's eschatological knowledge and experience in the entertainment industry make him uniquely qualified to comment on the value and significance of "The Road" for the faith-based community.
